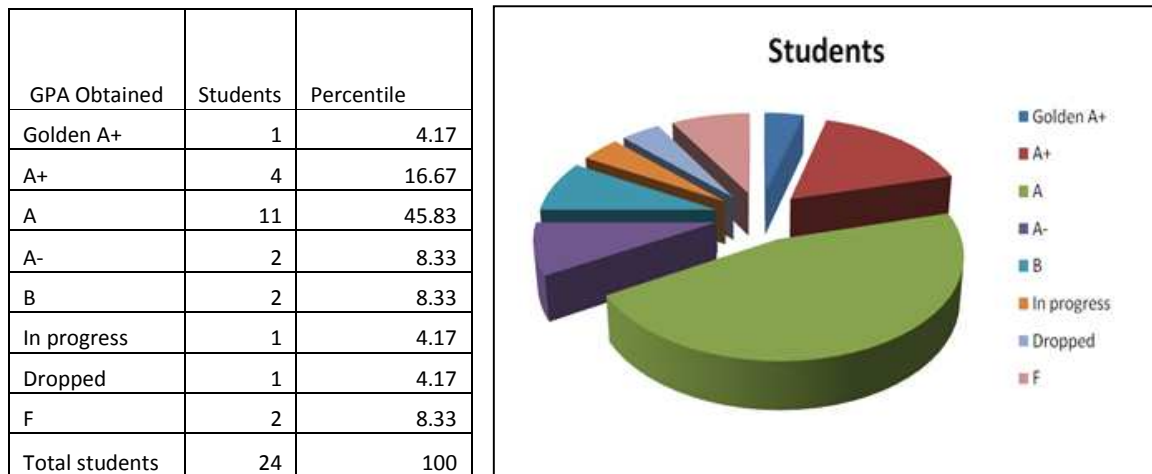


Project Title: Helping Some Brilliant Bangladeshi Students in Continuing Their Education

Hridoya Bangladesh first started working with some underprivileged students to get them over the primary boundary of passing SSC examination. But without any further financial support, some of the students dropped out of schools which made our efforts seem futile. After this realization, Hridoya Bangladesh launched this project in 2007 with the aim of helping some needy but bright students in continuing their college education. With the generous financial support from a lot of kind hearted people staying in different parts of the world, Hridoya Bangladesh supported 43 students from the batch of SSC '07. From the year of SSC '08, many applications asking for funding for continuation of studies were submitted. Unfortunately, we were able to support only 24 (16 male and 8 female students were selected based on their outstanding SSC '08 achievements and financial needs) from 10 different districts in the last 2 years.

Table 1 shows the distribution of the student results in percentiles. In the last column, a pie chart shows the overall success of this project in terms of GPA achieved by Hridoya Bangladesh supported students.

Achievements of the students are very encouraging. Among all 24 students, one student achieved Golden A+ (the highest grade in all subjects) securing him among the bests in the public examination. A large portion of them (roughly 17%) achieved general A+ (might be missing highest grade in one or two subjects at most) and a significant portion (46%) secured A and some others got A- and B. Out of all these 24 students, one student went for a Polytechnic Institute after his SSC examination in 2008. He is in his third academic year now and we will be able to provide more update about him once he finishes this year. It was very unfortunate that one of our students Zakirul Islam had to drop out and join BDR to support his family even though he had a promising result of GPA 4.94 in SSC examination. Now, our

students are preparing for getting admission into different universities. We wish them success in every step of their lives. We also express our gratitude to all the donors who made it possible for us to make some of the students' dreams come true.
